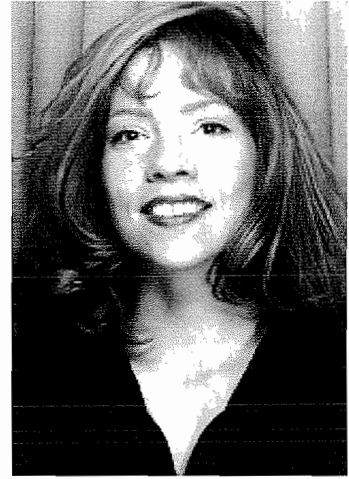

# We Miss You Angela

Angela Cowan joined the Wayne State debate team in September, 1993. She had no prior experience in debate and worked an average of 30 hours a week to pay her college expenses. She was a conscientious student who maintained nearly a 4.0 grade point average throughout her four years in college. As a debater, she encouraged coaches and judges to give detailed critiques, and she tried hard to apply the suggestions made to her. In her junior year, Angela qualified for the NDT, and she and her partner advanced to the double octafinals at the 1997 NDT.



In the summer between her junior and senior years, she was awarded a White House Internship. Following her graduation from Wayne, Angela was named to the United States Debate Team and spent six weeks touring England, Scotland, Ireland and Portugal. As part of that tour, she participated in many audience, club and parliamentary tournament debates and won several individual honors.

Angela planned on entering law school this past fall. Her LSAT scores placed her in the ninety-eighth percentile, and she was offered several prestigious scholarships to top flight law schools. She was to enter Harvard University Law School in August, but one week before her planned departure for Harvard she suddenly and quite unexpectedly collapsed at work and died almost instantly.

Angela was a person of extraordinary intelligence and energy. She was a lovely, good person who enjoyed the friendships and challenges of NDT debating. Her time on earth was much too brief, but her life was richly spent.

The Wayne State debate team and coaches dedicate the 1999 NDT to Angela Cowan.

I am pleased to welcome the fifty-third National Debate Tournament to the campus of Wayne State University. We are proud of our own debate team's long record of excellence in debate, and know how much the opportunity to compete at the NDT has meant to our students over the years.

It seems especially appropriate that the National Debate Tournament should come to Detroit and Wayne State University during a year when your debate topic is affirmative action. Southeastern Michigan has played a significant role in the struggle for civil rights in America. In the years before the Civil War, Detroit was a major destination point for the Underground Railroad. Rosa Parks, the courageous woman who began the Montgomery bus boycott, is a citizen of Detroit. Harbison, were members of the team who prepared the plaintiff's brief in the Brown vs. Topeka Board of Education school desegregation case.

We are pleased that the continuing dialogue over equal rights should receive particular focus on our campus this week. I look forward to meeting many of you personally, and I hope that your visit to Wayne State and Detroit will be a pleasant one. I congratulate you on qualifying for the NDT and wish you well.

## TOURNAMENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Directions from Hyatt Regency to Wayne State University:** Please note that on Friday morning you are driving in rush hour traffic, which tends to back-up as you approach Detroit and the University. A normal drive without traffic is approximately 20 minutes. You may want to add ten minutes to your driving time for rush hour traffic. Turn right out of Hyatt Regency parking lot on to Town Center Drive. Follow drive to the exit for Southfield Highway/Michigan Ave. East. Turn right onto the Service Drive following signs for Michigan Ave. East. Take Michigan Ave. for several blocks (3-4 miles). Enter I-94 East (entrance is on your right immediately past the second underpass – the sign for I-94 is often hard to see). Take I-94 east and exit at Trumbull. On top of the exit, continue straight through the light; **do not turn on Trumbull**. Look for NDT signs. This road will circle around the WSU sport complex. At the first light (Warren) turn left. Cross over the Lodge Expressway and at the first light turn left on the Lodge Service Drive. Manoogian Hall is immediately on your right. You will find members of the NDT Host Core to assist you in unloading. You will be directed to parking.

**Parking:** Parking on Friday is in Surface Lot 3 on Warren Ave. From Manoogian, continue on the Lodge Service Drive (it will loop around several parking structures – do not park there please; vans do not fit very well). The service drive will end at Anthony Wayne Drive; turn right. The first light is Warren; turn right and continue through two lights (back over the Lodge Expressway). The parking lot is on your right. **You will need a parking pass to exit. This will be available at registration and from the Host Core.** Parking on Saturday is Lot E and ET immediately across from Manoogian Hall and General Lectures on Warren Ave. No parking pass is required for Saturday and Sunday.

**Smoking** is strictly prohibited in all buildings. Please assist us by smoking outside and by using the ashtrays outside of the main entrances to each building.

**Competition Rooms** are located in the basement, first, and second floors of Manoogian Hall. Team tables and announcements are in the lobby of General Lectures (across from Manoogian Hall). Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be served in the Italian Room in General Lectures. Lexis/Nexis and Internet connections are available in the Undergraduate Library. The library is across Anthony Wayne Drive. Additional information is available at registration or from the Host Core.

**Please help us keep the competition rooms clean.** There are big garbage cans on each floor.

**Evidence Storage** is available on every floor. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR EVIDENCE IN YOUR LAST COMPETITION ROOM.** Signs will direct you to the room on your floor.

All printing done in the two computer labs will be free.

**Photocopy Service:** Free copying is available during tournament in 179 Manoogian Hall. Please only make the number of copies necessary for your immediate needs. The Hyatt Hotel has a copy service but it is available only during normal business hours. Kinko's is conveniently located five minutes from the Hyatt on Ford. Ask the hotel for specific directions.

**Team Photographs** will be taken Saturday afternoon between rounds five and six. Please proceed in a timely fashion after the conclusion of round five to 150 General Lectures to have your photo taken for the post-tournament booklet.

## THE HISTORY OF THE NDT

The National Debate Tournament began at the United States Military Academy in 1947. It was organized and conducted by the academy at West Point for its first twenty years. Initial tournament rules were determined by the West Point Administration in consultation with debate coaches such as A. Craig Baird of the University of Iowa, G.M. Musgrave of Des Moines, Alan Nichols of USC, E.R. Nichols of the University of Redlands, and Joseph O'Brien of Pennsylvania State University.

At the first tournament in 1947, 29 colleges participated in five "seeding" rounds and four elimination rounds over a three-day period. Some of the features of the tournament were that no school would meet a school within five hundred miles of itself during the seeding rounds and that no coach would judge a school from his or her own district. Many traditions were started at West Point that year, some of which still remain today: the "big board", oral announcement of round pairing, cadet escorts for each team, teams for each debate meeting under banner of the affirmative team, and team signs in the rooms.

In 1967, the National Debate Tournament entered a new era as the American Forensic Association, the national professional organization of forensics educators, assumed responsibility for the tournament. The NDT was moved from West Point and has been hosted by a different school every year since, although three schools (West Georgia, Miami University of Ohio, and the University of Utah) have hosted it twice. Procedures for the tournament are determined by the NDT Committee, which is composed of one member elected from each of the 9 districts and 4 members appointed by the AFA president. The NDT Board of Trustees is also appointed by the AFA

President, and it has the responsibility of overseeing all NDT financial matters. As debate has developed in recent years other refinements have been added to the tournament: cross examination, the 10-minute preparation time rule, elaborate procedures for assigning judges, judge qualifications, and computer-assisted research stations for participating schools. Over the years, the tournament has expanded in size to a maximum of 78 teams.

In the early days, district-nominating committees chose teams. This method was replaced by some form of qualifying tournament in most districts. For the first 20 years of NDT competition the tournament host and previous year's winner received automatic invitations. Post-districts at-large bids were initiated in 1968, and pre-district bids in 1971. Since 1970, it has been possible for a school to qualify as many as two teams for the NDT. Beginning in 1992, up to six schools can qualify a third team.

The National Debate Tournament is grateful to its corporate sponsor, the Ford Motor Company Fund. The NDT is also indebted to Mr. Sigurd S. Larmon (1891-1987) for donating the rotating Larmon Trophy, emblematic of the national debate championship; to Mr. and Mrs. George Walker for donating the rotating second-place Walker Memorial Trophy in memory of their son; to Mr. Robert Feldhake, top speaker at the 1976 NDT and now an attorney in Los Angeles for donating the Wayne Brockriede Top Speaker Award; to District IX for donating the rotating Top Speaker Trophy; the Copeland Family for donating the Rex Copeland First Team At-Large Trophy; and to Ovid R. Davis/West Georgia College for donating the Championship Coach Award.

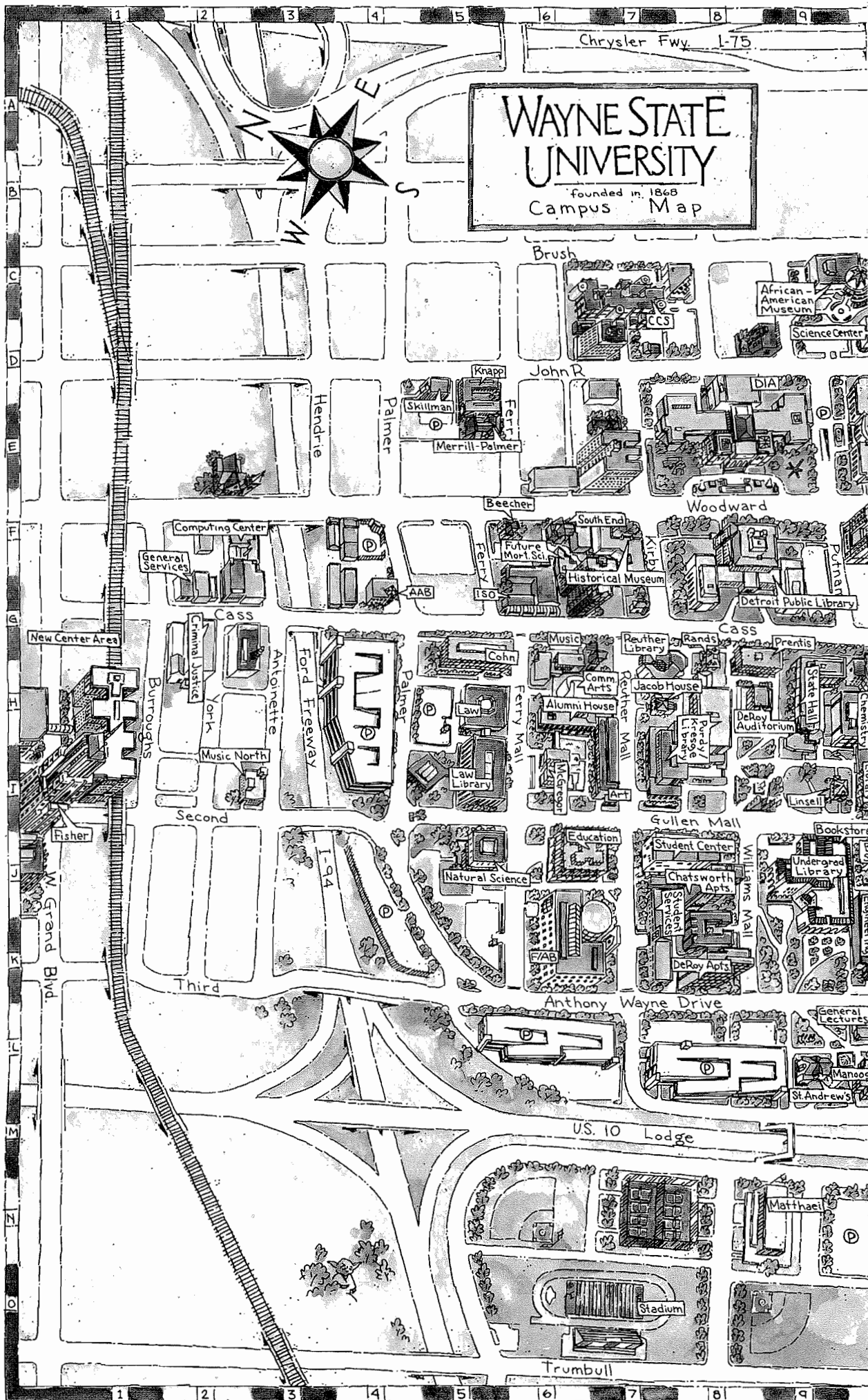

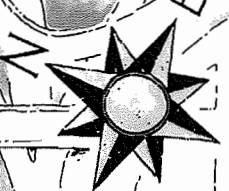

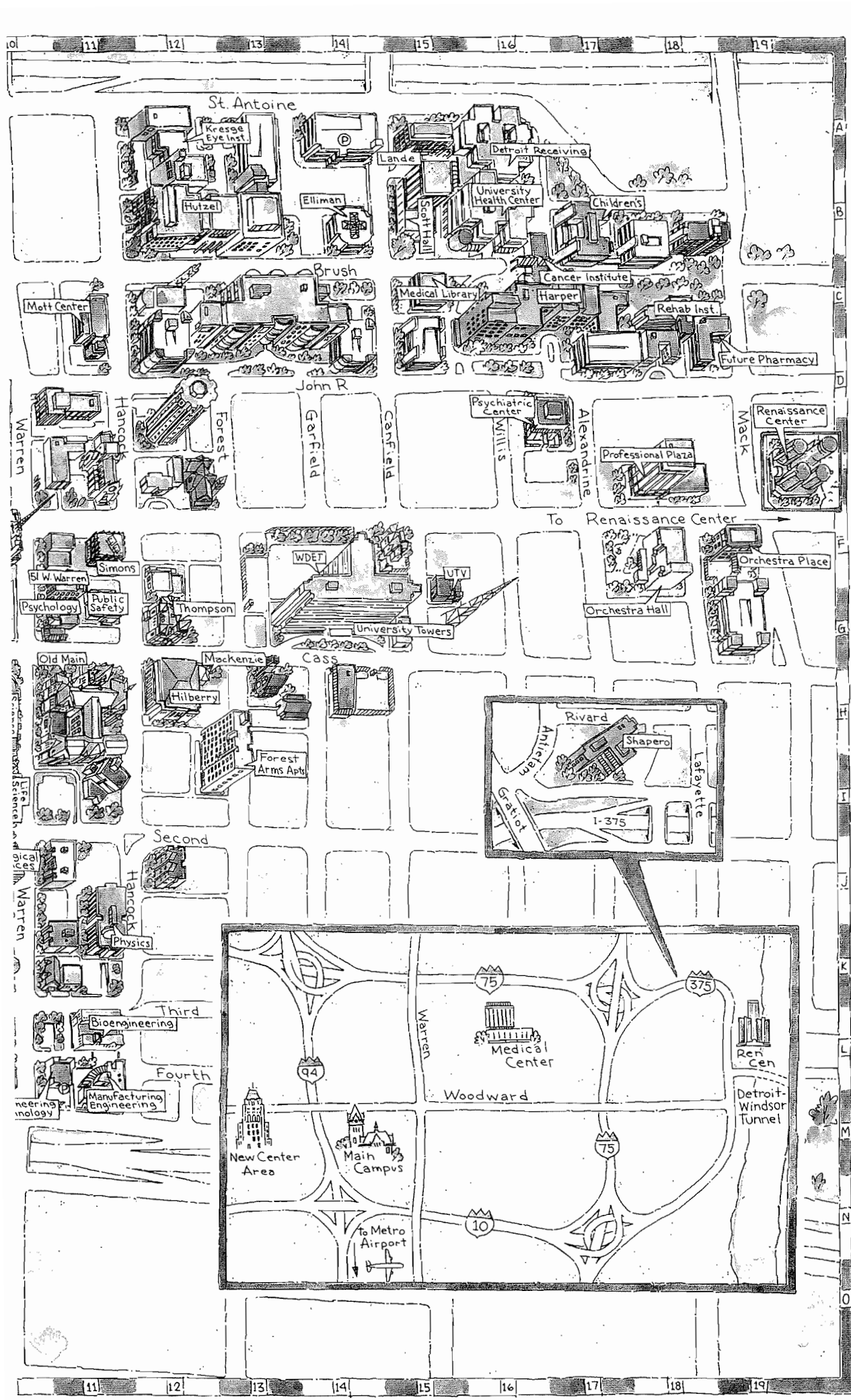
